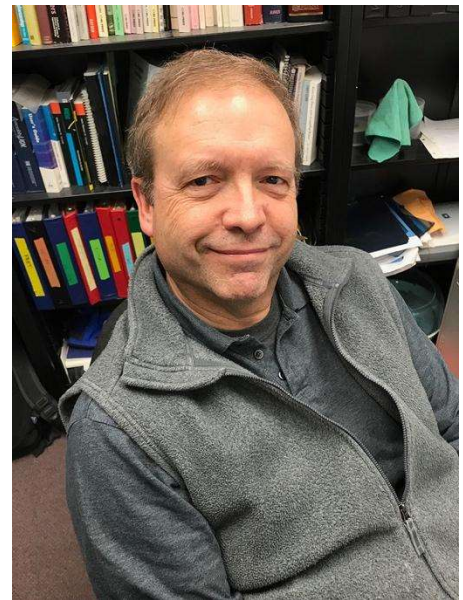


President: Ian Dickerson
